Stonehenge, Wiltshire - Until 30 years ago visitors could wander among the stones, now you have to stand behind ropes. But for just £13.70, you can get access to the circle when the site is closed to the public.

Palace of Holyroodhouse, Edinburgh - See the Queen's official residence in Scotland on an after-hours tour at 6.30pm every Thursday from 30 July-27 Aug. The £30 cost includes a glass of champagne.

Big Ben - It's free to climb to the belfry of Big Ben. To do it and to learn how they keep the clock so accurate, you need to write to your MP and join a waiting list of about six months. Details: www.parliament.uk.

Hardwick, Derbyshire - Spend the morning with the housekeepers as they put the home that belonged to Bess of Hardwick, the second-richest woman in Elizabethan England, to bed for winter. The event on 4 Nov costs £30, including a two-course lunch.

39th Bristol International Balloon Fiesta - will take place from 10th to 13th August 2017 offering four fantastic days of free family fun. The Fiesta is Europe's largest annual meeting of hot air balloons, attracting over 150 Hot Air Balloons from across the globe.

The event is completely free but charges are made for parking on the event site. There will be a large number of great trade stands, fairground rides and entertainment.
